

Steve Maslowski Named Excellence In Craft Contest Winner

Outdoor Journalist Takes First Place in the TV/Video/Webcast; Outdoor Adventure Category and wins Overall President's Choice Award

Gulf Shores, AL (For Immediate Release) — Steve Maslowski was named an Excellence In Craft (EIC) Contest winner Sunday at the Outdoor Writers Association of America's annual conference.

Maslowski won first place in the TV/Video/Webcast; Outdoor Adventure Category for his video "Wildlife Photographer: The Life of Karl Maslowski", which aired on WCET (PBS Cincinnati), KET (PBS Kentucky), and Vimeo. This entry also won the overall President's Choice Award among Blog, Magazine, Newspaper, Radio/Podcast, TV/Video/Webcast, and Photography contests.

With an \$8 secondhand camera bought during the Great Depression, Karl Maslowski (1913-2006) launched a storied photographic career. He introduced millions of Americans to the wonders of nature through his work for Audubon, Disney, National Geographic and others. He served as a WWII combat cameraman and earned the Outdoor Writers Association of America's highest honors for conservation.
